Travel information and tips

The Venice – St. Moritz Tour can be taken on any day of the year and lasts – depending on your schedule – around 8 hours. Starting 2008, guided tour packages will be available with reserved seating in 1st class (except on the Vinschg railway and Swiss yellow PostBus, which offer only one class).

Guided tour arrangements

June 18 – 22 and September 24 – 28, 2008

- Day 1: Venice (individual arrival), overnight in Venice
- Day 2: Vicenza and Verona, overnight in Bozen
- Day 3: Bozen, Vinschgau and Münstertal (overnight)
- Day 4: Convent of St. John , Swiss National Park, St. Moritz (overnight)
- Day 5: Individual journey home

Tips for individual travelers

- > Timetables for the entire route: www.sbb.ch (enter «Malles/Mals» and «Merano/Meran» in the fields).
- > Information and tickets from Switzerland to Malles/Mals (Italy) and from Merano to Venezia Santa Lucia available at any rail ticket counter in Switzerland. Tickets for the Vinschg railway (Mals–Meran) can be purchased at Zerneß railway station, from the PostBus driver, on the train or at the ticket counters of the «Südtiroler Verkehrsverbund» at Mals and Meran railway stations. - > In view of the route's scenic beauty and its cultural wealth, at least one overnight stop along the journey is recommended. Day visitors are advised to travel lightly and bring snacks (train/bus changes!).
- > Starting May 2008, www.erlebniszuege.ch will be offering attractive tour arrangements from Switzerland that include accommodation. They can be booked at any railway ticket counter.
- > 4 – 6 changes (train/bus).
